

## **CHECK OUT THESE GAME-CHANGING FAST FACTS!**

- In Canada, prostate cancer is the most common cancer among men and the third leading cause of cancer-related deaths from cancer in men. Prostate cancer diagnoses among Canadian men average 67 per day, with an average of 13 daily deaths from the disease.
- **PSA** (Prostate-Specific Antigen) is a protein produced by the prostate gland. Higher PSA levels in a blood test can indicate prostate cancer.
- **PSMA** (Prostate-Specific Membrane Antigen) is a protein that is abundant on prostate cancer cells.
- **PSMA PET** (Positron Emission Tomography) scan can be used to detect cancer progression and to see where in the body it might have spread.
- PSMA PET scan is a useful tool that is the launching pad for doctors to implement a precision approach that allows doctors to "SEE WHAT THEY TREAT AND TREAT WHAT THEY SEE".
